Steven Isserlis and London Contemporary Orchestra to perform at Ron Arad's *Curtain Call*

Internationally renowned artist, architect and designer Ron Arad will present two evenings of music as part of the live performance programme for *Curtain Call* - his unique 360° installation for the Roundhouse, **running from 9 - 29 August**.

Internationally acclaimed cellist **Steven Isserlis** will perform solo suites by Bach and Britten on **Wednesday 17 August at 7.30pm**.

London Contemporary Orchestra, conducted by Hugh Brunt, will perform live on **Tuesday 23 August at 7.30pm**. A 20th-century repertoire for strings, interspersed with a selection of Thomas Tallis' choral masterpieces, will explore the Roundhouse sonically and spatially with modern music on ancient themes.

Ron Arad's *Curtain Call* is a canvas for films, live performance and audience interaction. Arad has invited his favourite artists, musicians and friends to create unique work, including Babis Alexiadis, Hussein Chalayan, Matt Collishaw, Ori Gersht, Greenaway & Greenaway, Christian Marclay, Javier Mariscal, SDNA, David Shrigley, and students from the Royal College of Art for *Curtain Call*, which is part of Bloomberg Summer at the Roundhouse.

Steven Isserlis says: "It'll be a fascinating experience to play surrounded by Ron Arad's installation - a new experience for me. I've chosen three very different works: Bach's glorious, joyful third suite for cello, in the most positive of keys, C major; a very different third suite, Britten's, a meditation on death in the tragic key of C minor (which always seems to bring out the best in composers); and a wonderfully fresh and original work by my friend Carl Vine."

Hugh Brunt, Artistic Director and Principal Conductor, London Contemporary Orchestra says: "Curtain Call is a fantastic opportunity for us to collaborate with one

of the UK's most iconic designers, creating a programme which reflects his design with some of the 20th century's greatest music."

Ron Arad says of *Curtain Call*: "Walk in, penetrate, cross the moving images to get inside the cylinder. You'll be engulfed by images – a captive, but also a creator. It's amazing what exciting things happen on both sides of the curtain. I can't wait."

Stephen Isserlis has had a distinguished career as a soloist, chamber musician and educator, with an award-winning discography. Awarded a CBE in recognition of his services to music and the Schumann Prize of the City of Zwickau; he has performed with the Berlin Philharmonic, Budapest Festival Orchestra, Washington National Symphony, Philharmonia Orchestra, The Cleveland Orchestra and Vienna Symphony.
